The Elizabeth Hospice offers a clinical program to train psychotherapists in all aspects of grief and loss. This upto 18-month clinical experience provides training to developing clinicians who are interested in the field of grief, loss and life transition.

Our professional clinical staff supervises and serves as mentors to share their expertise. Clinicians have the opportunity to work with a diverse population of adults, children, couples, families and groups – supporting the family system before and after the patient’s death. Internship experiences include individual and family counseling in homes, care facilities or office settings, school-based grief groups on campus, collaboration with the hospice interdisciplinary teams, support group facilitation, children’s grief camp, and workshops and special memorial events for our community.

In addition to the clinical supervision and training, the value of the experience is having the honor of making a difference in someone’s ability to move through his/her grief.
